**A4123 Wolverhampton Road / New Birmingham Road Route Improvement
Consultation Proposals**

Sandwell Council is developing proposals for improving junctions along the A4123 Wolverhampton Road and A4123 New Birmingham Road. These improvements will help to reduce congestion at junctions through upgrading traffic signals and improve safety for pedestrians through the provision of new and upgraded pedestrian crossings.

In order to explain the proposals and gain your views, a number of consultation exhibitions are being held on the Network West Midlands Exhibition Bus.
